

North Texas Cross Country Circuit  
Meet #2—Myers Park (September 19, 2020)

Team Drop off and Camps

- Varsity teams may begin arriving at 6:15 a.m. (no earlier).
- Teams need to set up their camps/tents away from others.
- When not actively exercising/warming up, athletes will need to wear a mask; this will include approaching the start line and standing at the start line

Buses will drop athletes off at the pavilion at the front of the park.

\*All spectators must park in the west parking lot.

Starting

- For each start, we will utilize a wide start line, providing at least one box between each school. There will be large flags to indicate the start line
- Athletes need to wear a mask to the start line. Coaches will need to collect masks just prior to the start. Directions will be given at the line as to when they can take them off. Please check your team's box after the start and clean up any masks that may have been put on the ground.

Spectators

- Spectators will be allowed, but spectators need to maintain social distancing and wear a mask when 6 feet of separation cannot be maintained.
- Spectators are not permitted near the start line, finish line or team camp areas! **Spectators must remain on the west side of the course away from the start & finish lines as well as the tents and team camps.**

Transition Between JV and Varsity

- Upon completion of the last Varsity race, all varsity teams must collect their belongings and head to the buses any cool down must be down away from the venue
- JV teams may begin arriving at 8:30 a.m. (no earlier).
- JV teams will not be allowed to unload until all varsity runners and teams are cleared from the course.
- All other guidelines will be followed for the JV races.

Teams competing

- Myers Park--McKinney High, Jesuit, Allen, Braswell, Plano East, Wylie East, Wakeland, Centennial

Schedule of Events

- 7:30 a.m.--Varsity Girls 5K followed immediately after by Varsity Boys 5K
- 9:30 a.m.--JV Girls 5K followed immediately after by JV Boys 5K

Each school must provide one worker (can be a parent or coach) to assist with the running off of the meet. These volunteers need to report to the finish line by 7:00 a.m. to receive instructions.

Timing will be handled by Compton Time and Measure. We will have results posted online after the conclusion of each race.

The finish line will be roped off to protect the finish line from interference. Please pay special attention to the boundaries near the finish line.

Entries--Coaches need to submit entries through TX Milesplit and the deadline for entry will be Wednesday, September 9 at 5:00 p.m. Coaches MUST assign athletes a bib number within their range of BIBS they receive.

In the event of bad weather, such as lightning delay, athletes will report to their buses for shelter. Coaches will be notified when it is safe for their athletes to return.

We will utilize a two loop course at Myers. See the attached map. The course will be marked well with small electrical flags and paint at significant turns. Large turns will also be marked with posts and pennant flags. Coaches and athletes are responsible for knowing the course in advance of the race.

Medals will be handed out to the top 10 finishers in each division at the finish line.

Coaches will receive their bibs with timing chips (200) for the entire circuit at the first meet. It will be the coaches responsibility to keep up with these bibs throughout the entirety of the circuit. Once an athlete competes with a bib, please discard it so it does not interfere with the timing of future meets. In the event a coach loses bibs, that school will need to pay for a replacement bib.

At the conclusion of each meet, teams are responsible for picking up trash in their team area. Please do not leave any trash behind.
